The Dream Builders Project is a strong advocate for human rights – believing that it is every person’s basic right to have freedom, shelter, food to eat, and medical assistance as needed. Homelessness is a key social issue in many cities, especially Los Angeles. The DBP’s very first community outreach event was orchestrated to feed the homeless. The “Care Package for the Homeless” event has evolved into a staple of The DBP and is now held multiple times a year. A large group of staff and volunteers gather at a public predetermined location for an exciting, impactful event in less than an hour. During this time, care packages are filled with donated food, water, clothing, personal care items, and first aid items, and are delivered to some of the thousands of people living on the streets of Los Angeles. The event immediately impacts volunteers and homeless individuals, and hopes to provide some relief to those who need it.

- The DBP has provided educational assistance around the globe in countries including the Philippines and Cuba. Domestically, The DBP has offered assistance throughout California and North Carolina

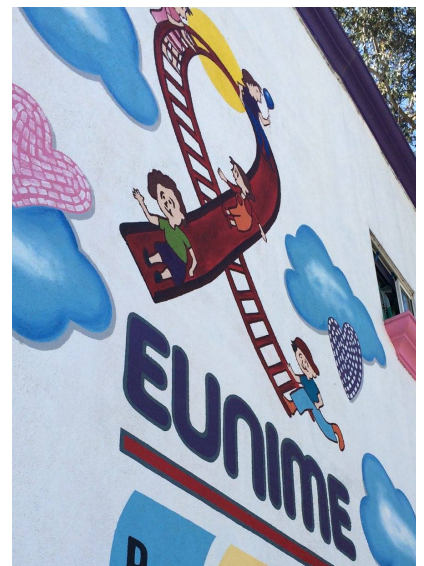
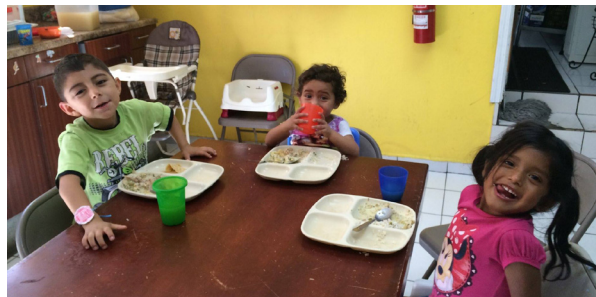
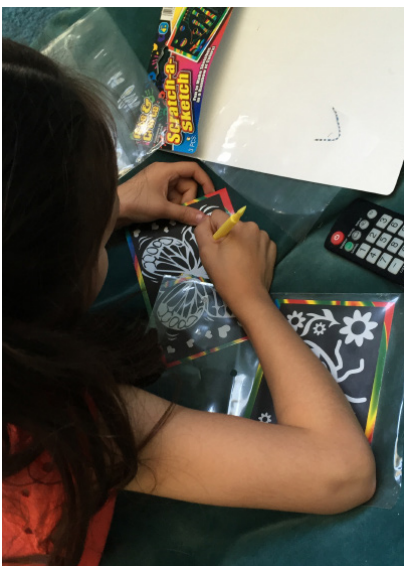


THE DREAM BUILDERS PROJECT EUNIME ORPHANAGE

The Dream Builders Project makes an annual trip to the Eunime Orphanage in Tijuana, Mexico in May. During this action packed one-day trip, The DBP staff and volunteers bring the orphanage any requested personal and sanitary supplies, food, medical supplies, and remodeling tools for updating the orphanage. Upon arrival, the team of staff and volunteers spends the morning interacting with the children at an off-site location. The team then makes its way to the orphanage to do minor repairs and cleaning, interact with children playing with their new toys, and experience first-hand the great work being done by the Eunime staff. As of May 2016, The Eunime Orphanage cares for 27 children affected by HIV and AIDS between the ages of 2 and 17.

During the trip in May 2016, the kids were very enthusiastic to show The DBP team around their rooms and play spaces, proudly pointing out their bedrooms and favorite toys. Observing how happy and joyful these kids truly are made everyone's hearts sing. The amazing staff at Eunime have raised and cared for the children, with minimal resources, in a safe, clean, and comfortable environment.

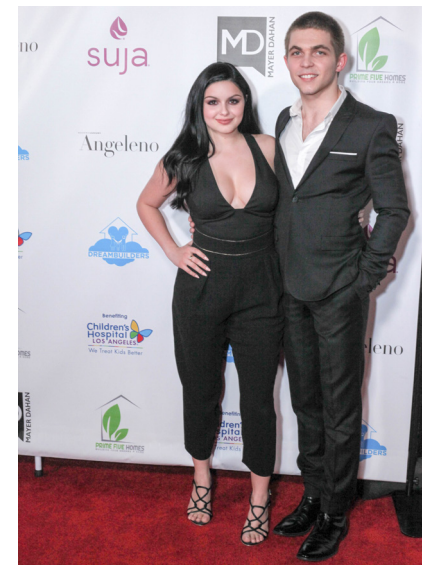

THE DREAM BUILDERS PROJECT HUMAN TRAFFICKING

The Dream Builders Project is a strong advocate of human rights -- believing that it is every person's basic right to have freedom, shelter, food to eat and medical assistance as needed. In 2015, The DBP began its first International Anti-Human Trafficking Campaign to raise awareness about modern day slavery and the traumatic, lifelong effects it has on its survivors. The DBP has partnered with the Los Angeles Police Department to be of assistance and to better educate the public on human trafficking with an emphasis on prevention. The DBP plans to further assist the LAPD by providing supplies for survivors of human trafficking and serve as a bridge to connect survivors with organizations that provide comprehensive rehabilitation to break the cycle of exploitation.
